

Five simple steps to success



Step 1 Pick an idea.

Whether you have a fundraiser in mind or you choose to use one from the suggestions listed in the fundraising ideas, this is the first decision to make.

Step 2 Plan your activity.

Even the simplest activities need some planning and preparation. The better prepared you are, the more smoothly your activity will run, helping you to raise even more for Headway Northampton. Think about how you're going to raise funds and what will work best for you. So if you're putting on a social event, will you charge an entrance fee, or price drinks and nibbles individually?

Step 3 Promote your fundraiser.

Once the details are decided, it's time to drum up lots of interest from your friends, family, workmates and all your social contacts! The more people you tell, the more donations you'll attract. To get your news out there you can make posters and flyers, write to the press, put an advert in what's on guides and use social media.


Step 4 Pay in your money.

Once the fundraising's over, it's time to collect donations and send them to us. If you've raised funds online through VirginMoneyGiving, then all donations will be sent directly to Headway Northampton. If you've collected donations yourself, then you can either pay those directly into our bank or you can hand it in in person and we can take it to the bank.

Step 5 Pat yourself on the back.

All your hard work has paid off. The funds you've raised will help Headway Northampton maintain the service we provide. Thank you so much for everything you've done.

Guidelines, hints and tips





If you send any donations or sponsorship money directly to us, please make sure it is clearly marked with your name/company and that it is funds raised for your event. Cheques should be made payable to **Headway Northampton**.

Please ensure that you take adequate steps to record and account for any donations you receive.

Fundraising materials

We have tried to include all the materials you need in this pack. However, if you would like leaflets and information about our work to support your fundraising, please let us know.

Charity number

When fundraising for Headway Northampton C.I.O., please remember to state that the event is 'in aid of Headway Northampton C.I.O.' and provide our registered charity number – 1158332 – on any fundraising or publicity materials.

Using the Headway Northampton C.I.O. logo

You are welcome to use our logo for fundraising purposes. Should you wish to use the logo, please contact Liz on 01604 591045 or administrator@headwaynorthampton.org.uk. She will send you an electronic version of the logo together with our logo usage guide.



Keep it safe and legal

Food Hygiene

Food hygiene Food safety laws apply when food is available whether it is for sale or not. Ensure you follow food hygiene procedures. Contact your local council for food hygiene regulations at events or see food.gov.uk.

Licences

Ask your local authority whether or not you need to obtain any special licences (e.g. public entertainment, collection or alcohol licences). If you are holding the event in a public place, you must have permission from the council or landowner.

Raffles

If you hold a small raffle on the day of your activity you do not need a licence, so long as all ticket sales and the draw itself take place during the main event. (It is okay if your event lasts more than one day.) To sell raffle tickets before or after your event, you must require a license. Tickets must be sold for the same price with no discounts applied. You must make it clear who is running the raffle. Check the latest information and advice at www.gamblingcommission.gov.uk.

Risk assessments

Identify any hazards and assess any risks at your activity that you'll need to consider. Ensure you have adequate first aid cover Keep it safe and legal available for the scale of your activity. If you're not sure, check with your local council.

Insurance

Please remember you are responsible for the activity and Headway Northampton cannot accept liability for any fundraising activity or event you undertake. If you are planning an activity that involves the general public you'll need to budget for public liability insurance, which can be obtained from any insurer. If you are holding the event in a venue which has liability insurance (such as a village hall or pub) check they have the appropriate insurance and that it covers your activity.



Collections

It is illegal to carry out house-to-house or public street collections without a licence.

The money

For your own protection, if at all possible, make sure you count the money you've collected with another person present and have them verify the total amount raised. Ask people who want to make a donation by cheque to make it payable to Headway Northampton rather than you personally. Make sure any cash donated is kept in a secure place and is banked as soon as possible.

Get consent

You will need to get parental permission if children are helping or if you're taking photographs of children. Children under the age of 17 must be accompanied by an adult. If your event is on private property, get permission from the owner or manager.

Remember

Keep records of everything you do for future reference.

Collecting Donations

There are a number of ways you can collect donations. We have outlined a few below, and are happy to discuss other options with you.

Virgin Money Giving

Virgin Money Giving is a service used to raise funds online.

Every penny of the money that donors contribute (excluding credit and debit card charges) is paid into our bank account.

Please be aware that other fundraising websites take up to 5 percent of the fundraising.

You can set up your own sponsorship web page by following these instructions:

How to set up your own sponsorship web page on VirginMoneyGiving

You can simply follow the instructions on the website, but for extra assistance, here are all the steps from the beginning.

- Go to the Virgin Money Giving website the address is https://uk.virginmoneygiving.com/giving/
- 2. Create a personal fundraising account and press "Start Fundraising"
- 3. Sign in or set up an account using your email address. Or you can continue with Facebook.
- 4. Enter details of your fundraising activity and choose your event. If you're organising your won event, choose "I'm doing my own thing."
- 5. Search for the **Headway Northampton**
- 6. Select "Create my page"



Money in cash or by cheque

If you have decided to collect your sponsorship money in cash or by cheque, we are happy for you to give this to us directly. Please let us know a time when you are coming and bring your fundraising along with your sponsorship forms. We will then pay this money into our bank account.

Gift Aid

Gift Aid allows Headway Northampton to get more for every pound you raise. For every pound that is Gift Aided, we will get an extra 25p because we can claim back the tax payable to HM Revenue and Customs.

For a sponsor to Gift Aid while donating, they need to be a UK taxpayer and also give consent. If you're using sponsorship forms and want to ensure Gift Aid is claimed, then:

- You need to get the person's first name and last name;
- Ensure the person provides their full **HOME** address including postcode;

If you're collecting an amount from a single person then:

- The Gift Aid declaration form has to be completed and signed by the person donating;
- The donation must be dated.

If you decide to use VirginMoneyGiving, the sponsor will be given the option to give Gift Aid on screen. This is a lot easier!
